We are all very lucky to be celebrating such a momentous occasion as the Queens' Jubilee; 70 years on the throne so come wearing red, white and blue on **Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May!**

We have a lot planned in the week leading up to our afternoon celebrations. Children will be studying our Monarch including looking at chronology, family tree and the life of the Queen. They will have a glimpse into the Queen's busy role, being the head of state, Commonwealth and the Church of England amongst her many other responsibilities.

We will be plotting where the Queen has visited during her 70 years in service. Did you know she visited Halesowen and drove past school in 1957!

## Lunchtime

Children will be eating lunch at their normal time and, hopefully, on the school fields. An afternoon tea style lunch can be booked on School Money, there **will not** be other menu options available on this day. This will need to be booked by **Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May** as after this time, no other booking for our Jubilee afternoon tea can be made.

## Afternoon

We would like to invite parents (one per child) in to be part of our afternoon Jubilee celebrations. Each year group will be setting up an activity that you can visit with your children. We appreciate that many of you will have children from different year groups and we have arranged the activities in a carousel format for you to participate in, at your own leisure, with your children.

As you can appreciate, we need to ensure all children are safe. There will be children moving around the activities with their parents and some children staying with staff. Can I please ask that everyone adheres to the following arrangements:

- Parents arrive by 1.30pm at the field gate on the church carpark
- Children will come onto the field and sing
- Children will be sent to their parent to participate in the activities (please note that your child/children will be your responsibility until the end of the session)
- 2.30pm: parents to take their child/children back to their class teacher/s
- Singing of National Anthem
- 2.45pm (ish): children to go back to their class
- 3.00pm: children will be dismissed to parents who have attended the jubilee afternoon (normal pick up point)
- 3.00pm: ice cream van will be on the church school field. All monies raised are for Compton Hospice

- If the weather isn't kind and it rains, I am afraid the event will be cancelled due to not having the indoor space
