Curriculum Newsletter Summer 25



English:

This term in English, while using 'the Write Stuff' approach, we will focus on developing our editing skills and being secondary school ready. Our writing will be based on the following texts/video shorts this term: Macbeth- A Shakespeare Story, the narrative poem Moth by Isabel Thomas, Origin of the Species by Sabina Redeva. Year 6 pupils are expected to spell a wide range of words accurately; use a wide range of punctuation; proofered, edit and re-draft their work before publishing. Could I please ask for your support in ensuring your child completes their weekly grammar homework. Our reading texts are —Skellig (contd) and Boy at the Back of the Class and High Rise Mystery.

Mathematics:

Year 6 will spend the first few weeks of the term revising the curriculum for our SATs. We will continue to have daily mathematics lessons afterwards to ensure children are secondary ready and that their arithmetic skills are secure. We will also spend some time completing some mathematical investigations.

Science:

Evolution and Inheritance

Children will recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago.

<u>Geography/History — How do I explore the world?/How has Halesowen changed over time?</u>

Year 6 will consolidate their knowledge of the Key Stage 2 Geography curriculum; we will establish our location on the planet and expand our knowledge of physical and human geography by expanding our knowledge beyond our local settlement. In history, we will conduct a series of lessons exploring the changes in our local area over time, looking at the first settlers to the changes in land use and population changes because of the Industrial Revolution. We will compare this with who and how we live locally today.
